The decision to introduce this new voluntary agreement has been made on the back of the overwhelming survey result in favour of its introduction, as outlined below.

Of the responses received from Parents/Guardians:

- 97.2% were in favour of a 'No Smartphone Voluntary Code' with immediate effect
- 0.9% would support a phased approach to a 'No Smartphone Voluntary Code'.
- 1.9% were not in favour of a Voluntary code.

Parking

Walk or cycle to school if possible.

Park farther from the school and walk the rest of the way.

If driving, use the gate farthest from the bottom of the road to drive in.

Please don't use the staff car park or the staff spaces just inside the gate, across from the bike rack, or in the new bus parking area outside the school.

Reverse parking on the right.

Drop off on the left.

Please respect the needs of the whole school community.

Try not to make a habit of waiting in the line with your child every morning. This is a difficult habit to break, and it makes drop-off very difficult if the car park is full due to parents waiting in the line with their children every morning.

Meabhrúcháin /Reminders

The following is the advice of Allianz- who are the national Primary School insurers:

The school will open to receive pupils at the hour of 8.50 a.m. No responsibility is accepted for pupils arriving before that time. No pupils should arrive later than 9.10 a.m.

Classes will end each day at 2.50 p.m. Parents who wish to have their children escorted home should make their own arrangements to have them met at the school gate and the person to escort them should be at the school not later than 2.50 p.m.as the school cannot accept responsibility for looking after the children after that time.

In the case of children travelling by the School Bus, the school cannot accept responsibility for escorting them from the bus to the school or from the school to the bus. Parents who feel that their children may need to be escorted in these circumstances should make arrangements to ensure that some escort is provided.
